
HIKER GUIDELINES

Native Landscapes and Garden Center

A Harlem Valley Appalachian Trail Community Center Garden Center hours of operation: 9am-5pm daily for mail pickup.

THIS IS A PLACE OF BUSINESS. Please rest here for no longer than 30 minutes and leave by closing time at 5pm.

* Wear clean shoes inside Garden Center.

*Limit time in the bathroom. Our bathroom is for customers and staff as well. Be

respectful and clean up after yourself. Do not wash clothes, brush teeth or shave in the

bathroom.

- Hikers may rest briefly on the gazebo in Garden Center.
- Garbage and recycle basket is on porch.
- NO ALCOHOL, SMOKING or OPEN FIRES ON PREMISES.
- Do NOT sleep among the plants.

Water:

Please obtain water from exterior spigot labeled on the southwest corner of the building.

Showers:

• Use of outdoor shower only: for a <u>quick</u>, <u>clothes-on</u>, <u>rinse-off only</u>. It's located on the southwest side of the building. Please be mindful of time.

Electrical Outlets: Located on porch posts: one is on the north end of the porch and the other on the south end. Additional outlets are located by the pond.

Overnight Stay: There is **no overnight camping** at the Garden Center. The Telephone Pioneers Shelter is just below Cat Rocks about 3 miles south. Heading north, the Wiley Shelter is 4 miles up. Tony's Deli (.6 miles south) offers overnight camping for \$2.

Resupply: Native Landscapes offers a small selection to hikers inside garden center. Please see staff. Hiker log book is located inside the Garden Center at the hiker table with other info.
